SECOND EXTENSION OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 6

SUBJECT: EXTENSION OF THE STATE OF CIVIL EMERGENCY RELATED TO THE
COVID-19 EPIDEMIC

WHEREAS, on March 18, 2020, in order to protect people from substantial harm, I declared a state of civil emergency arising from the COVID-19 epidemic; and


WHEREAS, Tenn. Code Ann. § 58-2-110(3)(A)(v) limits a declared state of emergency to seven days but authorizes extensions in seven-day increments; and

WHEREAS, emergency action remains necessary to protect people from substantial harm related to the COVID-19 epidemic.

NOW THEREFORE, I, *John Cooper, Mayor of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County*, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me, do hereby proclaim, direct, and order the following:

The State of Civil Emergency declared for the area of the Metropolitan Government on March 18, 2020, is extended for seven days from this date.
